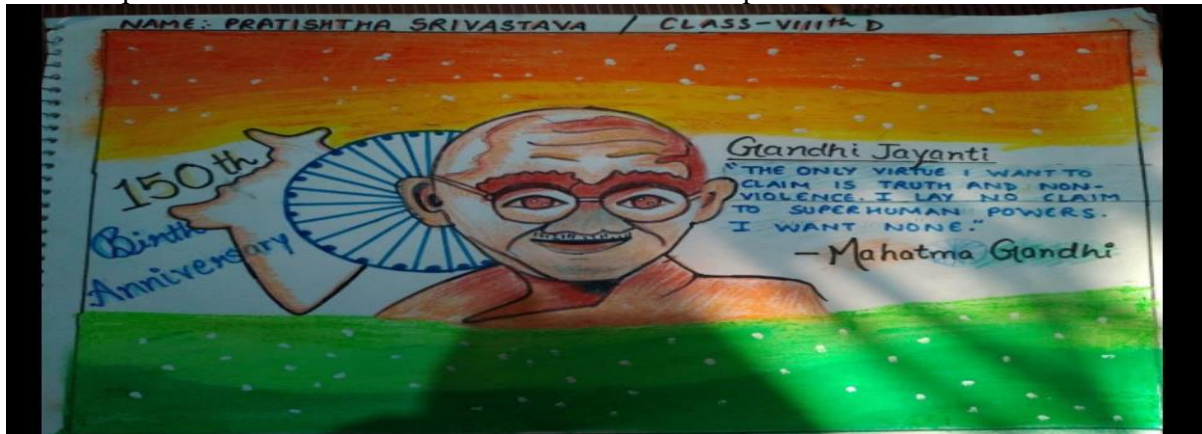

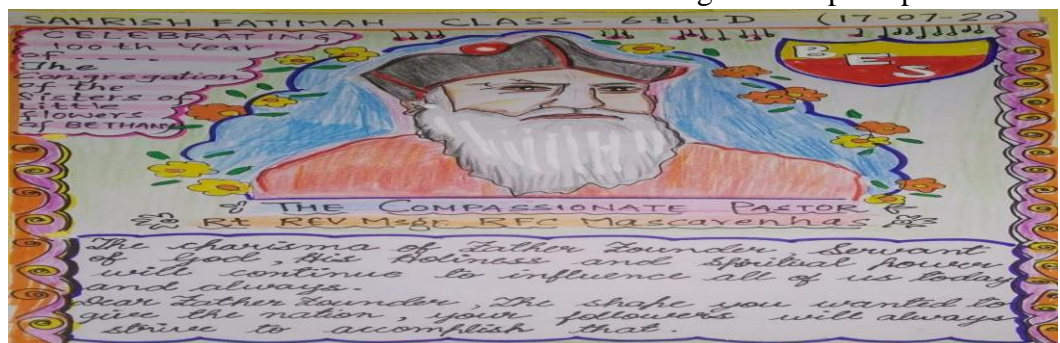
17. **CENTENARY CELEBRATION OF THE CONGREGATION-ACTIVITIES:**
